


Kentucky Nursing Home Outbreak: Real World Applications

90.4% of residents and 52.6% were staff were vaccinated.

Asymptomatic and unvaccinated staff member came to work. The identified variant was E484K.

- Lower infection rates
 - 25% vs 75% among residents
 - o 7% vs 30% among staff
- Lower hospitalization rates
 - 3% vs 50% among residents
 - no staff were hospitalized
- Lower death rates
 - 1.4% vs 25% among residents
 - o no staff died

Building Confidence


- 95% percent of doctors who have been offered a vaccine have taken it
- This figure helps builds confidence in conservative hesitant people
- Hesitancy can (and does) move to confidence
 - 20-50% of those eligible for vaccination express concerns and many go on to be vaccinated

Building Confidence

- Respect autonomy and independence
- Tailor messaging to the individual
- Vaccination increases freedom to see family and friends
- Trusted messengers

Tools for Providers

- Share personal vaccine stories
- Counter misinformation and disinformation
- Address concerns transparently and head on
- Remove barriers to accessing appointments
- Offer COVID-19 vaccines during routine care when possible
- Display locations of local vaccine clinics and registration information

How Telehealth Can Help

- Opportunity to provide information to clients and address concerns
- Safe atmosphere for high risk and immune compromised patients to discuss
 COVID-19 vaccines with providers
- Personalized client follow up opportunities
- Opportunity to provide information during specialist appointments, such as pregnancy appointments
