

Telehealth Booths Now Available for Providers!

Background:

- In partnership with Wyoming public libraries, the Public Access Telehealth Spaces (PATHS) project creates publicly accessible, ADA-compliant, and secure telehealth booths using existing library infrastructure.
- The PATHS booths offer Wyoming citizens a private space with reliable internet and necessary technology to be able to connect with provider appointments from the public library. Users can create appointments with Wyoming-licensed providers (e.g. mental health, physical health, specialists, nursing, consultations, and health education) independently, and access the appointment from the booth in the library.

- Park County Library (Cody Branch)
- Goshen County Library (Torrington Branch)

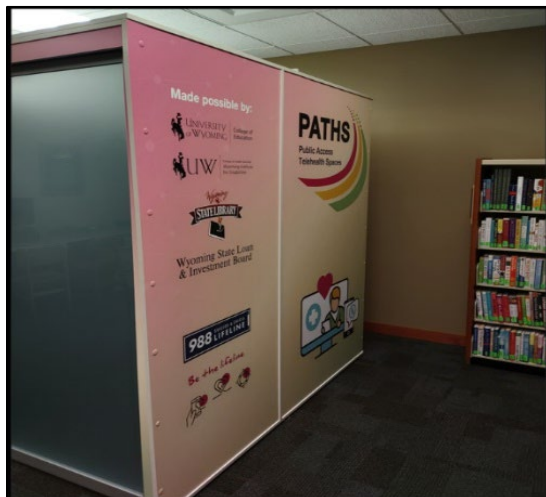
What is Available:

- Soundproof, HIPAA-secure booth
- Library support staff
- Technology (computer, speakers, internet connection)
- Medical peripherals for remote patient monitoring.
