Why Telehealth Matters in Rural Healthcare


Improves access in underserved areas

Enhances continuity of care and outcomes




Where Are the Doctors?




- Nationwide, only 8% of physicians work in rural areas
- Rural communities have one-ninth the number of specialists
- Rural areas have 2.4 times fewer primary care physicians compared to urban areas

Critical Gaps III Rural Health Access





live in a county with no practicing oncologist



- The mortality gap between rural and urban populations has nearly tripled in the last two decades



From Challenges to Solutions


Telehealth is not a silver bullet, but it is a powerful bridge—connecting rural patients to the care they deserve.




