Medication Management



Multidisciplinary Approach: Ancillary Care Referrals

Physical Therapy (PT): posture, gait, fall prevention

Occupational Therapy (OT): activities of daily living support

Speech-Language Pathology (SLP): swallowing, communication strategies

Seamless referral workflows through telehealth platform

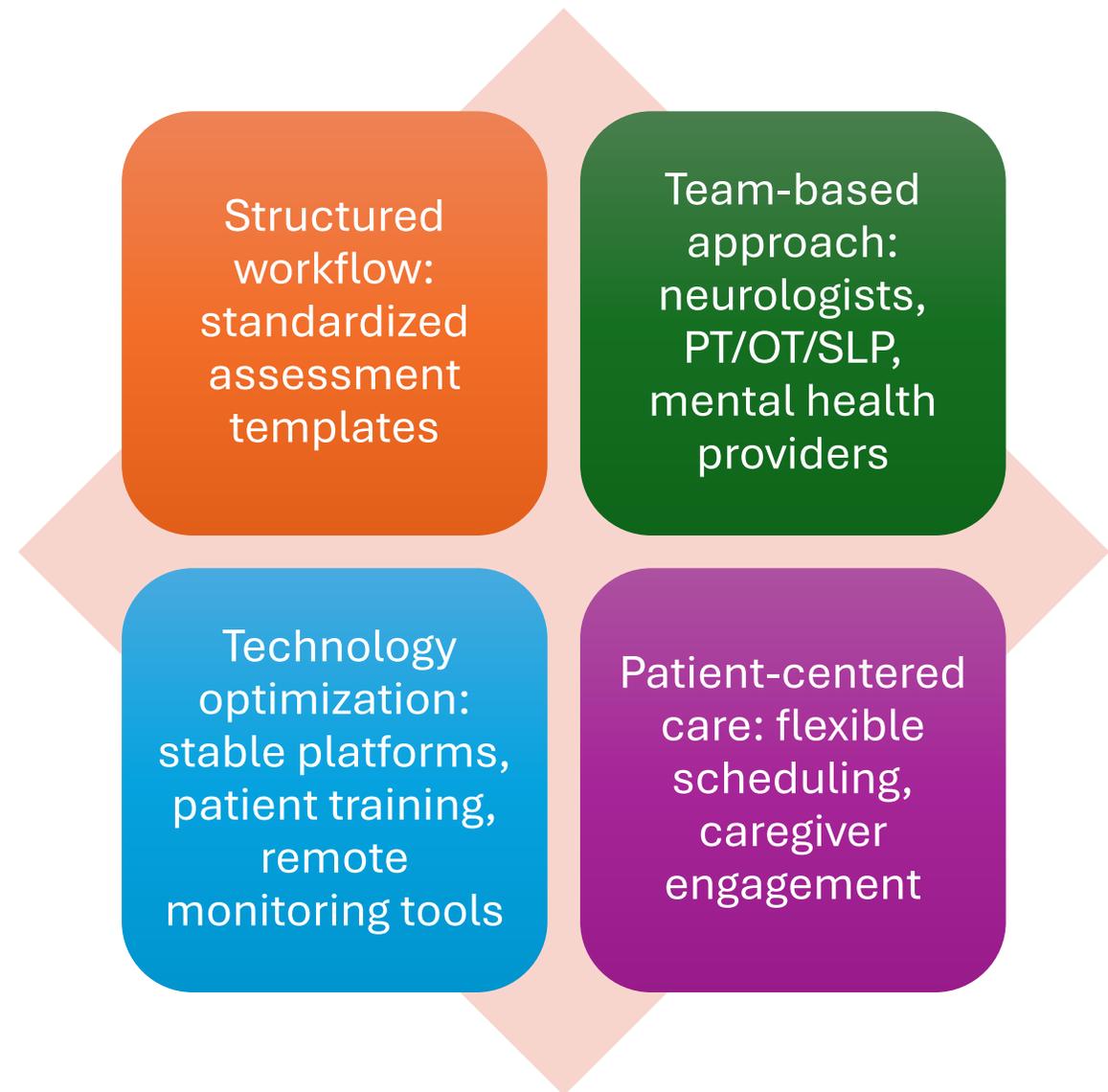
Advanced Therapies via Telehealth

Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS): candidacy assessment & evaluation, seamless collaboration with surgeon and device representatives, remote DBS programming

Pump therapies (levodopa/carbidopa infusion, apomorphine): candidacy assessment, Rx, titration monitoring

Remote collaboration with surgical and specialty centers

Case Example 1

- Patient: 68yo man with 12 yr history of Parkinson's disease
- Challenges: mobility limitations, difficulty traveling, motor fluctuations

Telehealth Approach:

- Video-based motor exam to adjust levodopa dosing
- Referred to PT for gait training & fall prevention
- Connected with SLP (virtual, SpeakOut!) for swallowing strategies
- Monitored remotely for medication changes and advanced therapy candidacy

Outcome: Improved symptom control, reduced falls, empowered patient & spouse



Case Example 2

- Patient: 61yo female with 7 yr history of Parkinson's disease
- DBS implanted 2023

Telehealth Approach:

- Video-based motor exam each visit
- Remote programming using DBS secure software
- Adjust DBS as needed, follow patient closely via concierge

Outcome: Improved management, quick & accessible appts as needed, improved

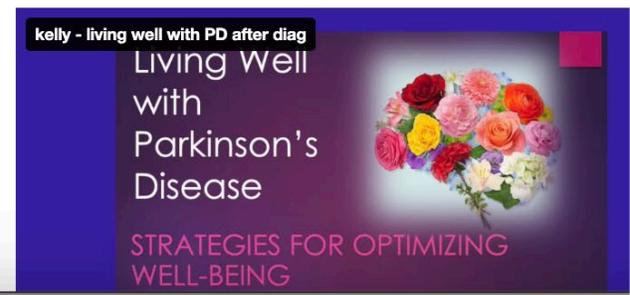
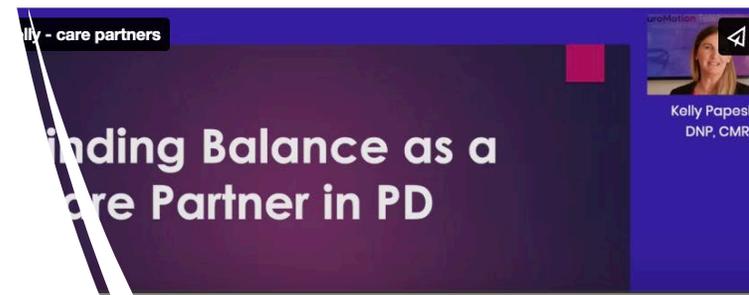
